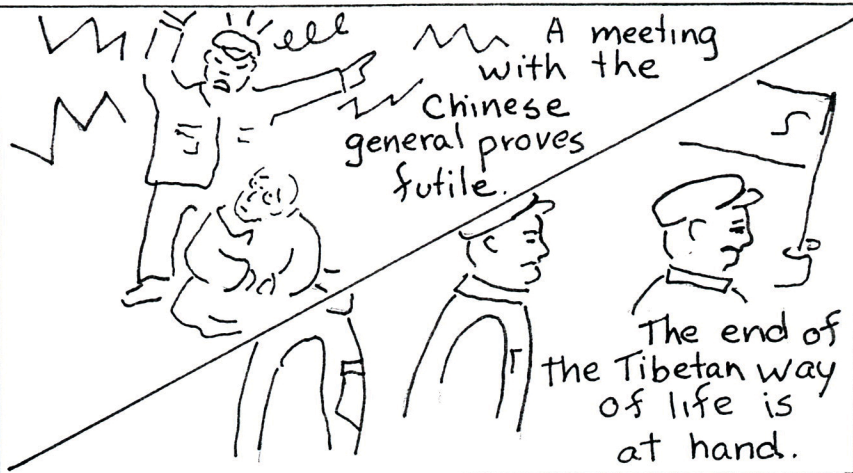


It becomes clear the Dalai Lama must flee his own country.



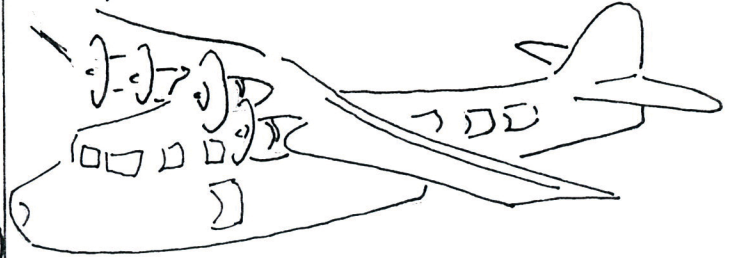
Four years later...

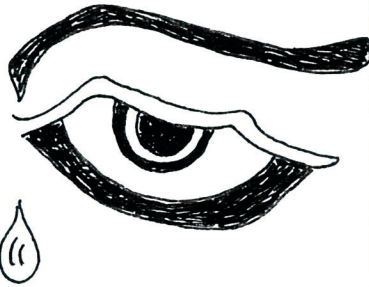
And you, sheep, NO BLEATING

The misery of the Tibetan people grew.



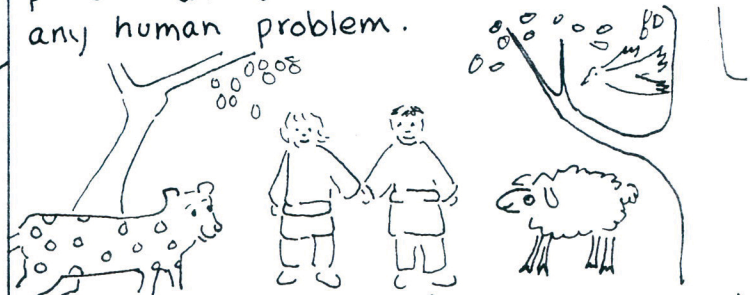
The Dalai Lama's response was to study the Buddha's teaching ever more deeply—reminding his people that compassion was the only solution.
